PORTS OF CALL

Oporto, Portugal

Known for and named after its internationally famed port wine, Oporto is characterized by its patchwork-like townhomes, Baroque churches, and cascading hills. History and tradition seep from the tiled exteriors of the Barredo quarter, while the village-style plazas, winding staircases, and veering alleyways radiate old-world charm.

La Coruña, Spain

Greeting you with a mesmerizing façade of glass-enclosed balconies, La Coruna, or “The Glass City,” has earned a reputation as a place where no one feels like a stranger. Home to Europe’s oldest working lighthouse and a town square named after famed heroine Maria Pita, this port is a place where historic tradition and modern innovation come to play.

Bilbao, Spain

Smart, laid-back, and culturally diverse, Bilbao is a hub for art and architecture. Beaming scales of titanium tile flash from Frank Gehry’s Guggenheim Museum Bilbao, serving as an iconic symbol of the city’s cosmopolitan revival, while Basque, French, and Spanish influences infuse the city with rich culture and international character.

Biarritz (Saint-Jean-de-Luz), France
